Fabric and Maintenance Projects

St. Ninian's: The upgrading of the parish hall has been put on hold. The cost is approximately £125,000 which would effectively leave the parish with no money. The archdiocese is not supportive of this project. Therefore, the plan now is to address the water ingress damage to the flat roofs to the Church which need urgent attention. The cost of this is expected to be significantly less.

Corpus Christi: The damage to roofs within the hall is now being addressed as is the external damage to the rear of the Church. It is hoped to cover this cost from the parish roof fund account.
